Second Vice Commander

Second Vice-Commander is the Chair of the Ways and Means Committee, assist with Veterans Affairs and Rehabilitation, public affairs and community outreach as directed by the Commander and shall assume and discharge the duties of the office of First Vice-Commander or Commander in the absence of disability of such officers.

Third Vice Commander

Third Vice-Commander is the Chair of the Americanism Committee, and shall assume and discharge the duties of the office of Second Vice-Commander, First Vice-Commander or Commander, in the absence or disability of such officers.

Finance Officer

The Finance Officer shall be the Chair of the Finance Committee, and responsible for overseeing the financial records of the Post.

Historian

The Post Historian shall compile and preserve a pictorial Post history for print and electronic distribution.

Sergeant-at-Arms

The Sergeant-at-Arms shall preserve order at all meetings and shall perform such other duties as may be from time to time assigned to him by the Commander.

Chaplain

Adjutant

The Judge Advocate's duties shall be to advise the Post Commander on the interpretation or modifications of the Post's Constitution, Bylaws, and Rules and Regulations, and be responsible for an annual financial audit and the Post
