## **Reports from Legion Family Members & Other Guests:**





<u>1st Vice Commander Bob Brennen</u> – Membership – We are at 75% of renewals and approximately 45 new members to be inducted this evening.



A member asked for an update about the status of Veterans 291 Yacht Club (Vet291YC). Commander Reynolds stated the Yacht Clubs Committee had provided recommendations to the E-Board. Those recommendations were approved including that transfer of membership from Vet291YC to the American Legion Yacht Club will be done based on the approval of the proposal by Vet291YC. The resolution of the issue is pending that approval from Vet291YC leadership. The approval is due by September 1, 2019.
