M/S/C to approve the Minutes of the July 10 General Meeting Minutes.


The motion was approved.

Then, he spoke about attending the American Legion National Convention. The Commander talked about the first place award presented to Post 291's Honor Guard.



He then encouraged members to join the Donations Committee and went on to ask for contributions to the Helmets for Heroes.
