

#### AL291 Marketing & Communication Committee Report To the E-Board April 2, 2020

Committee Meeting on 3/16 was cancelled

- A. Project: Sponsorships for the Vietnam Welcome Home weekend
  - 1. 37 solicitations were sent to local businesses
  - 2. 10 local companies agreed to sponsorships from \$1000 to \$500 and \$7,500 was received.
  - 3. Sponsors for \$1000 were: Humana Insurance, Fletcher Jones Motorcars, Stanley W. Ekstrom Foundation, TrueCar, and Community Foundation of Orange.
  - 4. Sponsors for \$500 were: Compass Real Estate, Patterson Custom Homes, Douglas Elliman Real Estate, Midas Tire & Auto Service, and C3Tech.
  - 5. On March 16 I received an email from the Commander telling me that the event was canceled and all sponsorships should be returned.
  - 6. Each was contacted and asked to "re-purpose" the donation to the VEAF and seven agreed to change the donation to the VEAF resulting in a new donation to the VEAF of \$5500. Humana asked that their donation become a "deposit" for a future event and two \$500 sponsorships were returned.
- B. Project: Memorial Day 2020 VEAF campaign
  - 1. An anonymous donor gave Doug Nye a check for \$25,000 for the VEAF. Donor asked that his Navy Seal brother be recognized.
  - 2. Initial email was sent to all veteran members on April 1 with a challenge to double each donation with this matching donation up to a total of \$25,000.
  - 3. An email will be sent each week requesting donations.
  - 4. A mailed request to veterans without email addresses will go on May 1.
  - 5. Request to add to the website a Memorial Day tribute page to a "fallen veteran" and the reading of these names at the Post Memorial Day service. This could be a combined effort with the AUX adding the names from their Poppy Month Remembrance Cards traditionally displayed in the bar on the mirror.
- C. Project: Buddy Checks as proposed by the National Commander and Ken Wilson
  - 1. Script has been prepared to reach all veteran members during the COVID-19 crisis.
  - 2. Request for membership information has been made to allow all veteran members to be called.
  - 3. Request modified for membership information for older veteran members as the initial effort.
  - 4. Request for a pilot test by Ken and Chase to evaluate the script and possible training needs for committee members making calls.



#### AL291 Donation Committee Report To the E-Board April 2, 2020

Committee Meeting on 3/17 was cancelled but list submitted by email to the committee

**Current Financial Results:** 6521 Unrestricted Service Officer expense plus VEAF expenses totaled \$18,667 for January 1 thru March 31 or \$6,222 / month. Revised Actual for 2020 is now forecasted to be \$70,000.

A. These veterans have received financial assistance to March 31:

- 1. Snider (Navy) application for \$375 for motel for his wife and two children who were homeless. This was shared with AL133.
- 2. McGowen (Army) application for emergency rental assistance of \$700 while out of work plus \$25 gas card and \$20 Target gift card for food.
- 3. Ward (Marine) application for \$600 for six night motel stay plus two gas cards over three weeks as he waits for a VASH apartment.
- 4. Ricard (Army) application for rental assistance of \$1,409 with AL133 paying \$500 because VASH messed up his payments last month.
- 5. Lipton (Marine) application for help with dental insurance deductible of \$750 for emergency surgery. Lipton is 69 years old and an AL291 member with very low income.
- 6. Luzell (Marine) application for \$450 for five night motel stay. She and her two children were homeless and living in a car.
- 7. Madnia (Army) application for help paying utility bills of \$467.50 because he is unemployed and looking for work.
- 8. Kurtz (Navy) for emergency car repair shared with AL133 for \$468.70.
- 9. Liggett (Army) application by his family for help to place a marker on his grave in Anaheim. Liggett was a Korean veteran and his family did not have the \$300 for installation of a marker on the grave.
- 10. Joseph (Marine) a veteran student at OCC for \$600 for rental assistance.
- 11. Taddeo (Army) for \$500 for rental assistance with AUSA and AL227 sending similar amounts to the landlord.
- 12. Hopkins (Navy) \$225 for motel for one week for her and three children paid to AL133 for half the weekly cost.
- 13. Powell (Navy) for \$500 for 5 nights motel to keep her off the streets.
- 14. Salazar (Navy) for 2 nights motel for \$180 after early release from County jail until VASH apartment is ready.
