- Chase Wickersham briefed the membership about the Marketing and Communication Committee.
 - Purpose: To create ideas and plans to improve profitability and fund raising and generate and draft communication from the Post for increasing community awareness and knowledge of Post Family activities.
 - Meetings are held monthly
 - Database improvement was discussed at the last meeting
 - Discussed a mailing to ask for missing information as well as an "opt in" question for members who
 previously opted out of email notifications.
 - Also had secured some funding for Welcome Home Weekend
 - 10 entities pledged support a total of \$7,500
 - When Weekend was cancelled, some \$5,500 was repurpose (repledged) to VEAF
 - Memorial Day VEAF campaign raise about \$65,000
 - Local businesses are willing to support Post activities just need to be asked
 - Asked E-Board to use the committee
 - Committee Chairman Wickersham says the Committee members feel they can increase daily Drive Thru sales to \$8,000 to \$10,000 per day
