On Going Post Operations — Rules

- · Drive-thru takeout meal service is available daily— and is open to the public
- For Post 291 Family members and their guests, outside dining at the Post is available daily on the patios — along with limited seating inside
 - o Alcoholic drinks may only be ordered and served with a meal but refills permitted
 - o Masks must be worn to enter the patio areas and when not seated at a table
 - o Masks may be removed while seated at a table for eating and drinking
 - o When reordering drinks from the bar, masks must be worn If you get up, mask up
 - o Social distancing continues as a requirement
 - o Tables set up on the patios are purposely spaced at required distances
 - o Tables are cleaned after each set of users has departed
- · No in-person meetings may be held at the Post
- All Post 291 Family meetings must be held by videoconference
- Only certain kinds of events are authorized to be held at the Post and these must be conducted within limits of numbers of attendees and with social distancing
 - o Religious e.g., Weddings
 - o Cultural e.g., Celebrations of Life

On Going Post Operations — Summary

- Along with outside seating on the patios, limited inside seating now allowed for restaurant operations — View Room and Bar area
- All meetings, events, and entertainment at the Post are canceled until further notice
- Marina is open and slip renters and dry storage renters have access to and use of their vessels
- Drive-thru takeout food service is offered and available, 12:00 noon to 7:00 pm Monday through Friday and 10:00 am to 5:00 pm Saturday and Sunday
- Reopening Planning Committee exploring options and methods for further reopening the Post
- Videoconferencing (Webinars) will continue indefinitely as the primary method for holding Post meetings
- Support of needy military veterans continues under the skilled direction of the Service Officer

Health and Safety Practices Required

- Health and safety of Post 291 Family and Post employees are the most important priority in reopening and operating the Post
- · Coronavirus (COVID-19) is still an omnipresent threat
- Essential to be considerate of fellow Post Family members and Post employees and their health and safety
- · Face coverings must continue to be worn
- · Social distancing must be continued
- Frequent hand washing and use of hand sanitizers is imperative
- Official direction, rules, and regulations must be followed
- Expect current operating mode to continue through March 2021
