



For many months now your Post has been unable to hold in-person meetings due to the pandemic restrictions. While there is light at the end of the tunnel, we will still not be able to hold the May General Membership meeting and election at the Post. However, due to a loosening of restrictions we will be able to offer you the option of voting in person at the Post or voting on-line. Here's how it will work:

For those of you who wish to vote in-person:

On Wednesday, May 12, at 2:00 pm we will open the Post to allow for voting inside the View Room. You will need to follow the commonsense restrictions of maintaining six feet of distance and must wear a mask at all times. You will enter the Post through the front entrance and present your current Post Membership Card at the Registration Desk. Once your eligibility is determined you will be given a ballot and directed to a voting table. Upon completing your ballot, you will then deposit the ballot in the official Ballot Box.

The in-person balloting will be open from 2:00 pm to 7:00 pm on May 12.

For those of you who wish to vote on-line:

At approximately 7:00 pm on May 12, we will hold the General Membership Meeting virtually as we have been doing for the past several months. By clicking on the "Meeting Registration" button below, you will be able to register for the meeting and will receive an automated email with the meeting link.

In order to vote on-line, you must attend the virtual General Membership Meeting and have not already voted in-person.

Following the normal course of business, the meeting will adjourn to allow for the on-line voting. Approximately 20 to 30 minutes following adjournment, those Members eligible to vote (Member in good standing and have not already voted in-person) will receive an email with a balloting link. When that email is received, Members can click on the link and will be taken to the web site containing the ballot for Post Officers. Please note that the online balloting is completely anonymous, and the system will not allow for more than one ballot to be cast.

For those Members who wish to 'try out' the online balloting method prior to the May 12 meeting, we will hold a practice and familiarization 'mock election' at 5:30 pm on Wednesday, May 5. On Monday, May 3, we will send an email to those of you who have registered for the General Membership Meeting giving you an opportunity to also register for the Mock Election.
