

Homeless Veteran Outreach and Rehabilitation Program

Objective: To provide several services to homeless veterans that are working towards getting linked to services such as housing, employment, behavioral health and the VA system.

Eligibility:

- Must be a homeless veteran with any discharge status and show proof of military status.

Services offered:

- Peer Support for any homeless veteran
- Transportation within the Orange County perimeter and to the VA Long Beach.
- Request birth certificates, dd214's.
- Provide DMV vouchers to homeless veterans.
- Provide resources and referrals to several veteran service providers including legal aid, vocational training, continuing education, employment, transitional living and permanent housing.
- Link and schedule homeless veterans to behavioral health services.
- Provide 30-day bus passes to homeless veterans depending on their income. (Upon request)
- Provide gas cards to homeless veterans depending on their income. (Upon request)
- Provide one-day bus passes to homeless veterans depending on their income.
- Provide hygiene kits, clothing and other essential needs requested by homeless veterans.
- Provide an emergency 3-day motel stay for one homeless veteran per month specially used for bridging the gap right before they are permanently housed. (Upon approval)
- Provide 1 x clothing voucher via Walmart. (Upon request)
- Provide Fast Food gift cards. (Upon request)

Program Goals:

- Outreach to 100 homeless veterans by end of December 2025.
- Successfully refer and link 50 homeless veterans to any VA clinic.
- Successfully refer and link 75 homeless veterans to any veteran service provider.
- Successfully refer and link 50 homeless veterans to any behavioral health service provider.
